It is understood and agreed:

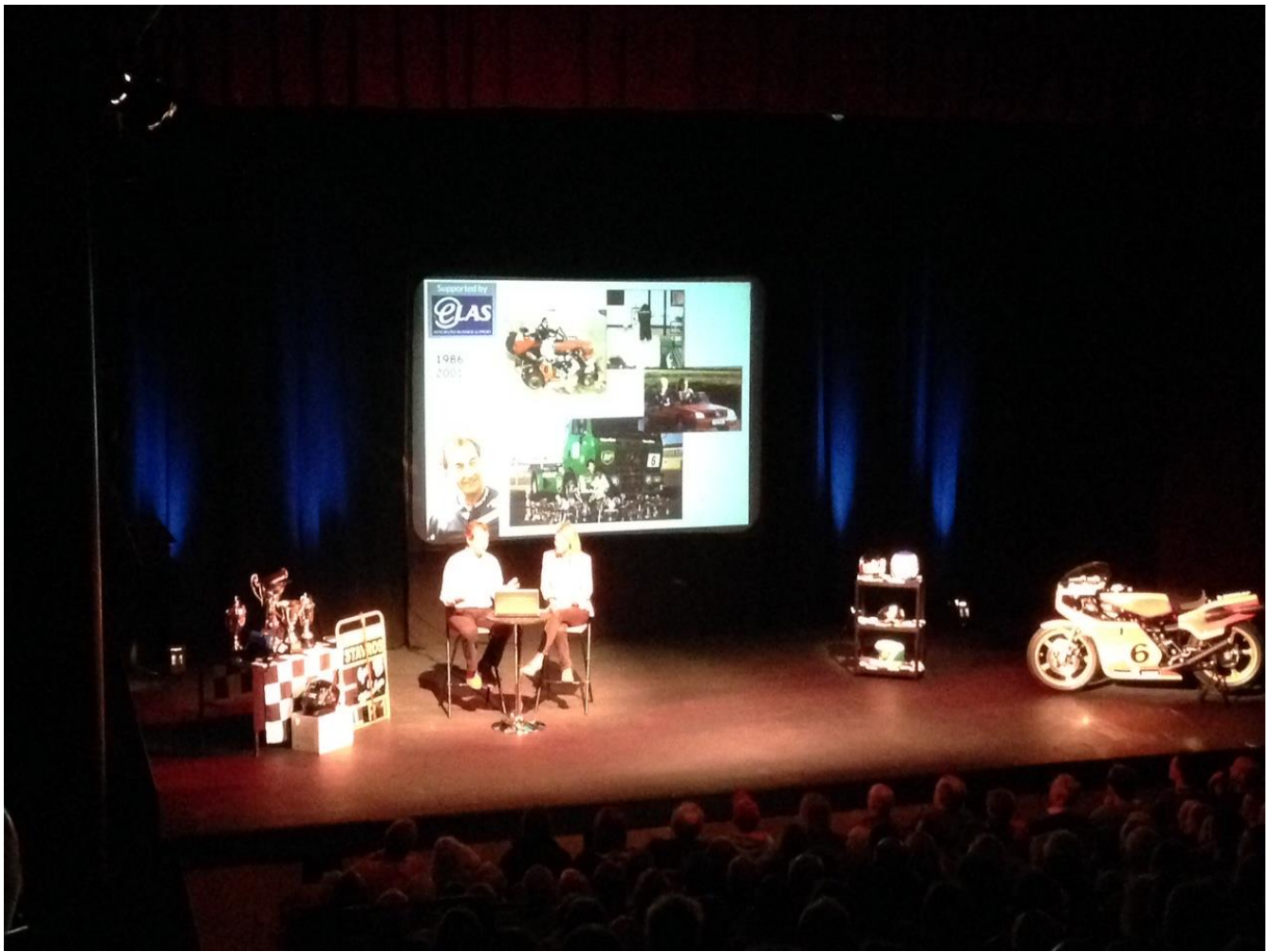
Get-in time will be approximately 3.00pm

1. The Theatre will provide **2 Head/Lapel microphones & 1 hand held radio microphone**
2. There is no requirement for a Follow spot as long as we have a special available to light Artists and stage features(see photo)
3. The Theatre will provide a stage for the Artiste. The stage needs to be able to accommodate set(see photo) if any doubt please email the stage dimensions to mike@iasml.co.uk
4. The Theatre will provide first class sound and lighting.
5. The Theatre will provide a small table ,a jug of iced water and 2 glasses for on stage and a 4ft x 4ft table
6. The Theatre need to provide playback for house music.
7. The Theatre will provide a projector and screen that will need a stereo feed to the house P.A. The screen to be positioned centre stage (see photo) Projector and sound feed is from the Laptop on stage.
8. The Artiste's performance will not be recorded in any way. Recording includes film, video, audio and TV. Neither may the performance be shown on closed circuit TV.
9. The full fee + VAT is payable to: INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS SPORTS MANAGEMENT LTD, by no later than: 2 weeks after the engagement.
10. The Theatre will provide two heated dressing rooms with shower facilities (if available), toilets, mirror and lighting for Mr Steve Parrish.
11. The Theatre will make arrangement for two parking spaces.
12. The Theatre will provide a dressing room for use as a green room if available
13. No unauthorised persons allowed backstage or in the dressing room area without permission of the artiste or his representative.
14. A minimum of 2 posters to be displayed in the venue foyer.
